### Marketing Agents Performance Related Commission – Section 10

**January 17, 2025** - As part of our ongoing review and optimization of our business strategies, we have made the decision to discontinue the existing commission structure, which was extended by the [Circular](#) dated March 26, 2021.

**Effective March 31, 2025**, the current commission structure will come to an end. After this date, commissions will be restructured according to our new policies, which will be communicated to you in due course.

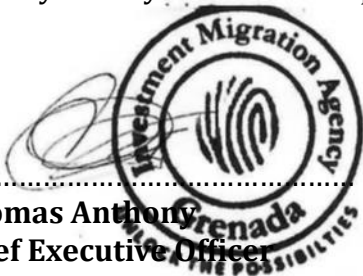
We understand that this change may require adjustments to your planning and operations, and we are committed to ensuring a smooth transition. Over the coming months, we will provide more detailed information regarding the new commission structure and any additional steps needed for a seamless transition.

Effective immediately, you are required to ensure that National Transformation Fund (NTF) Contributions are received by the Agency prior to the submission of invoices for commissions. Additionally, it is essential that invoice dates accurately reflect the date of submission to the Agency and are not unreasonably predated. Any invoices dated more than two days before submission will be returned for correction to include the actual submission date.

### Marketing Agents Performance Related Commissions, (Section 10).

The Grenada Citizenship by Investment (CBI) Unit hereby informs Marketing Agents, that the special incentives commission structure, to all Marketing Agents has been extended, as follows:

1. To be paid a commission of \$25,000.00 per approved application from 1 – 60.
2. To be paid \$30,000.00 per approved application from the 61<sup>st</sup> approved application to the 80<sup>th</sup> approved application.
3. To be paid \$35,000.00 from the 81<sup>st</sup> approved application onward.

The CBI Unit further informs that all Marketing Agents must meet these conditions listed above.
